

As part of Ark Valley's ongoing efforts to maintain line clearance, we will be continuing the process of spraying the right-of-ways in our service area to prevent further growth and to mitigate future expenses. This year we will spray half the system and the other half next year. Members affected will receive a letter in the mail when it's nearing the time for spray crews to be in your area.

Through the DriftWatch registry mapping program at <https://ks.driftwatch.org> you can register your specialty crops, vineyards, registered organic crops and beehive locations. You must be producing the crop for commercial use in order to register your crop. The site is not intended for homeowners who have small gardens. For BeeCheck you can use the site if you are a commercial or hobby beekeeper.
