- Day One** - Get Acquainted Banquet to meet the Youth Tour participants.
- Day Two** - Tour the Kansas State Capitol and Brown vs. Board of Education. Fly to Washington, D.C.
- Day Three** - Visit Old Town Alexandria and attend a theater performance.
- Day Four** - Tour Holocaust Memorial Museum, Arlington National Cemetery, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and Smithsonian museums. Take a dance cruise on the Potomac River.
